### MINUTES

The meeting was attended by the clerk, Cllrs Hutchinson, Jameson, North, Rycroft and Weedon.

#### 1. Apologies for absence

#### 3. Public speaking and question time

#### 4. To approve the minutes of the last two meetings

These were approved as a true and accurate record of the meeting after a minor amendment to the minutes of 11<sup>th</sup> May 2009.

#### 6. To discuss the Common Land (C179) at Mill Lane

Cllrs looked over the Commons Register for Bellerby and are confident that C179.1 belongs to Mill House.

#### 7. Update on works to edge the greens

The Parish Council had received a letter asking for confirmation that the Parish Council would contribute £1000.00 to the cost of edging the corners of the village greens. The clerk had replied that this was the case.

#### 8. Traffic Signs

Neil Linfoot of County Highways had written to say that moving the village signs would not be of benefit to the Highway user. This is not what Cllrs thought was agreed with M Linfoot and Sergeant Hunter of North Yorkshire Police at a recent meeting. The Chairman will write to Mr Linfoot querying his letter.

#### 9. Update on the footpath to Leyburn

The feasibility study is now in the process of being undertaken. A draft feasibility brief has been sent to the Rights of Way office at the County Council for approval in June, but no reply has yet been received.

#### 10. Correspondence

The Area Committee had written asking if the Parish Council wanted to put forward a representative for election to sit on the Area Committee. As any representative would have no voting rights and could only speak at the discretion of the Area Committee Chairman, Cllrs decided against this.

North Yorkshire County Council's Overview and Scrutiny Board had sent a copy of their Annual Report to March 2009.

#### 11. Planning matters

Full planning permission for "Construction of Steel Framed Lean To to Create Additional Workshop Space and Covered Area" at Manor Close had been GRANTED.

Full planning permission had also been granted for alterations at New Bank House, Moor Road, but the clerk hadn't received a decision notice from the Planning Department. The clerk will chase this and bring it to the next meeting.
