

BELLERBY PARISH COUNCIL

An informal meeting of the Parish Council was held which was attended by the clerk, Cllrs Hutchinson, North, Rycroft and Weedon together with PCSO Mandy Hoss.

Mandy explained her role as Bellerby's PCSO and said that she would like to get involved in any projects the Parish Council had ongoing and would lend her support wherever she could.

A date for an Environmental Visual Audit was set which Mandy would attend, together with our local Police Officer and members of the Parish Council. This would look at any problems in the village from say dog fouling to any antisocial behaviour observed.

Mandy will also write a piece for the village newsletter each time it is published.

The footpath project has now reached the stage where the feasibility study can be undertaken. £3000.00 has been secured from North Yorkshire County Council towards the cost and £500.00 from Bellerby Freeholders. An amount will be requested from the Parish Council and also from the Open Gardens event. Cllr Rycroft had attended a meeting of Leyburn Town Council earlier tonight to try and get help from there too. The study will cost between £5000.00 and £10,000.00.

A cheque was written out for Horton Landscaping for £322.02 for 2 grass cuts.
