MINUTES

1. Apologies for absence

4. To approve the minutes of the last meeting

All present agreed that these were a true and accurate record of the meeting and they were duly signed by the Chairman.

5. Matters arising from the previous minutes

Cllr Weedon is to chase Highways about the problem with the green opposite the pub. The clerk is to ask Horton Landscaping to look at the bare patches of green along the main road and ask how much they would charge to repair those bare patches of green.

6. Update on the footpath to Leyburn

Sustrans are still in the process of conducting the feasibility study. Farmers have replied to the various options, but have had no confirmation of receipt of their comments. Cllr North will chase Sustrans and ask them to confirm receipt.

7. Update on flooding problems

The pipes crossing the beck on Moor Road still haven't been moved. Cllr Weedon is still trying to find funding for a feasibility study.

8. To discuss collection of green waste from the cemetery

Currently no green waste collections are made from the cemetery. Richmondshire District Council had said they could provide a green bin and empty it fortnightly, but that there would be a yearly charge of £25.00 for the service. Cllrs agreed to this and asked the clerk to contact RDC and arrange for the bin to be delivered.

Horton Landscaping £346.63 2 grass cuts
